ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 6

The Washington State Board of Chiropractic Examiners gave notice to the Code Reviser (No. 2034), to other interested persons and to the press in accordance with RCW 34.04.025 and 42.32.010 on April 12, 1968 that a hearing would be held on Saturday, May 4, 1968 at 6:00 p.m. in the Chinook Hotel, Yakima, Washington, to consider the adoption of a rule setting standards for the accreditation of chiropractic colleges.

The Washington State Board of Chiropractic Examiners after holding a hearing at the time and place above specified, considering written comments and letters from both chiropractors and chiropractic colleges and also the oral statements made by persons in attendance, adopted the attached as a permanent rule in accordance with the authority conferred by RCW 18.25.017 and 18.25.020. The Board further directed that upon the recording of the order in the registry of the agency that the rules be forwarded to the code reviser for filing pursuant to chapter 34.04 RCW and chapter 1-12 WAC.

Chapter 114-12

BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS

AMD

WAC 114-12-020 DEFINITIONS. The following terms are defined for the purposes of this chapter:

- (1) "Board" means the board of chiropractic examiners.
- (2) "College" means an institution whose curriculum provides training leading solely to the acquiring of a professional or subordinate degree or degrees in chiropractic; or in completing work required for an academic degree in science.
