Employees eligible to participate in TIAA/CREF as identified in WAC 131-16-020 may choose the optional retirement transition benefit that at the time of their retirement permits receipt of an accumulated cash value of the combined annuities in the form of a cash lump sum payment as now or hereafter permitted by TIAA/CREF.
