ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 36
SBCCE ORDER REGISTER

A resolution relating to the general description of State Board organization and operations.

WHEREAS the State Board for Community College Education finds that the immediate adoption of an amendment to WAC 131-08-005 relating to the general description of State Board organization and operations is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare and that the observation of the requirement of notice and opportunity to present views and proposed action will be contrary to the public interest in that there exists a need to give the amendment immediate effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the State Board for Community College Education that it adopt Administrative Order No. 36 and the annexed amended regulation identified as WAC 131-08-005, made a part hereof by this reference, as an emergency rule.

This resolution and the annexed amended regulation, after being first recorded as an administrative order in the Order Register of the State Board, shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing as an emergency rule pursuant to Chapter 34.04 RCW.

WAC 131-08-005 GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF STATE BOARD ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS.

(1) The State Board for Community College Education consists of seven members appointed by the Governor. Successors of the members initially appointed serve for terms of four years. For the academic year 1974-75 regular meetings will be held on September 18, 1974; October 31, 1974; December 11, 1974; January 23, 1975; March 6, 1975; April 16, 1975; May 14, 1975; and June 25, 1975. The location of each meeting is available at the State Board offices, 319 Seventh Avenue, Olympia, Washington 98504.

(2) The executive officer and secretary of the Board is the director of the state system of community colleges. He is in charge of the offices of the Board and responsible to the Board for the preparation of reports and the collection and dissemination of data and other public information relating to the state system of community colleges. He exercises, in the name of the Board, all powers and duties delegated to him by the Board and at the direction of the Board executes, together with the chairman of the Board, all contracts entered into by the Board.

(3) It is the Board's duty to exercise general supervision and control over the state system of community colleges consistent with the specific powers and duties set forth in the Community College Act of 1967, Chapter 28B.50 RCW.

(4) The Board's office is located in Olympia, Washington, 319 Seventh Avenue, 98504.

Information and assistance may be obtained at the Board office. Formal submissions or requests to the State Board should be addressed to the director at the Olympia office.
