(2) ALTERNATIVE B. Use only for Adoption of Emergency Rules.

We, the County Road Administration Board find that an emergency exists and that the foregoing order is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare and that observance of the requirements of notice and opportunity to present views on the proposed action would be contrary to public interest. A statement of the facts constituting such emergency is:

County road departments cannot now do work for other county departments without prior approval of the board of county commissioners. This emergency rule is required, until a permanent rule can be adopted, in order to permit county road departments, acting under Board policy, to do work for other county departments without specific individual Board approval. Such rules are therefore adopted as emergency rules to take effect upon filing with the code reviser.

(3) Pursuant to the requirements of RCW 34.04. (1977 c 19 § 2) that "every agency shall incorporate the most specific, but in no case omit all, of the following language alternatives when adopting or amending rules" (fill in statement (a), (b), or (c) as appropriate):

STATEMENT REGARDING WORK FOR OTHER PUBLIC AGENCIES

I. NAME OF AGENCY: COUNTY ROAD ADMINISTRATION BOARD

DESCRIPTION OF RULES: Under the authority of RCW 39.34.100, Interlocal Cooperation Act, counties are enabled to do work for other public entities in conformance with the bid statute applicable to the entity receiving the services.

II. SUMMARY OF RULES:

WAC 136-32-030 Procedure-Interdepartmental. requires that whenever the county road department does work for other county departments, the request to do this work needs prior approval of the board of county commissioners for each project. This emergency change to WAC 136-32-030 is needed in order for county road departments, acting under board policy, to do work for other county departments without board approval for each project.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: RCW 36.78

REGARDING WORK PERFORMED BY OTHER PUBLIC  
AGENCIES BY THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT

AMENDING ORDER #15, FILED 7-30-70

WAC 136-32-030 PROCEDURE -INTERDEPARTMENTAL ((When ever a department of the county desires work to be performed by the county road department, the department must submit a written request to the county engineer, describing the work requested, financial considerations, and time for performance or completion. The county engineer shall examine the request and submit to the board of county commissioners with his recommendations and comments. The board shall in writing either approve, modify or disapprove said request. All such work performed by the county road department for and on behalf of other departments of the county shall be on a reimbursable cost basis in accordance with terms set forth in the request and approved by the board.)) All work to be performed by the county road department for other departments of the county shall be done in accordance with the board of county commissioners' policy regarding approval of work for other public agencies and county departments as required under WAC 136-10-050 (4).
