1 AN ACT Relating to the state board of registration for professional
2 engineers and land surveyors; and amending RCW 18.43.030.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.43.030 and 1986 c 102 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 A state board of registration for professional engineers and land
7 surveyors is hereby created which shall exercise all of the powers and
8 perform all of the duties conferred upon it by this chapter. After
9 July 9, 1986, the board shall consist of ~~((seven))~~ nine members, who
10 shall be appointed by the governor and shall have the qualifications as
11 ~~((hereinafter))~~ required in this section. ~~((The terms of board members
12 in office on June 11, 1986, shall not be affected. The first
13 additional member shall be appointed for a four-year term and the
14 second additional member shall be appointed for a three-year term.))~~
15 On the expiration of the term of any member, the governor shall appoint

1 a successor for a term of five years to take the place of the member
2 whose term on said board is about to expire. However, no member shall
3 serve more than two consecutive terms on the board. Each member shall
4 hold office until the expiration of the term for which such member is
5 appointed or until a successor shall have been duly appointed and shall
6 have qualified.

7 Five members of the board shall be registered professional
8 engineers licensed under the provisions of this chapter. Two members
9 shall be registered professional land surveyors licensed under this
10 chapter. ~~((Each of the))~~ The engineer and land surveyor members of the
11 board shall have been actively engaged in the practice of engineering
12 or land surveying for at least ten years subsequent to registration,
13 five of which shall have been immediately prior to their appointment to
14 the board. Two members of the board shall be public members who shall
15 have the responsibility of representing the interests of consumers.
16 One of the initially appointed public members shall serve a term of
17 three years.

18 Each member of the board shall be a citizen of the United States
19 and shall have been a resident of this state for at least five years
20 immediately preceding his appointment.

21 Each member of the board shall be compensated in accordance with
22 RCW 43.03.240 and, in addition thereto, shall be reimbursed for travel
23 expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of this chapter in
24 accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.

25 The governor may remove any member of the board for misconduct,
26 incompetency, or neglect of duty. Vacancies in the membership of the
27 board shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the
28 governor as hereinabove provided.
