1 AN ACT Relating to port districts; and amending RCW 53.12.260.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 53.12.260 and 1985 c 330 s 3 are each amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Each commissioner of a port district shall receive ~~((fifty))~~ one
6 hundred twenty-five dollars per day or portion thereof spent (a) in
7 actual attendance at official meetings of the port district commission,
8 or (b) in performance of other service in behalf of the district:
9 PROVIDED, That no commissioner shall receive compensation ~~((to exceed~~
10 ~~five thousand eight hundred dollars))~~ for more than one hundred sixteen
11 days for any calendar year: PROVIDED FURTHER, That no commissioner of
12 a port district shall receive compensation ~~((to exceed four thousand~~
13 ~~eight hundred dollars))~~ for more than ninety-six days in any calendar
14 year if the port district had gross operating income of less than
15 twenty-five million dollars in the preceding calendar year.

1 For any commissioner who has not elected to become a member of
2 public employees retirement system before May 1, 1975, the compensation
3 provided pursuant to this section shall not be considered salary for
4 purposes of the provisions of any retirement system created pursuant to
5 the general laws of this state nor shall attendance at such meetings or
6 other service on behalf of the district constitute service as defined
7 in RCW 41.40.010(9): PROVIDED, That in the case of a port district
8 when commissioners are receiving compensation and contributing to the
9 public employees retirement system, these benefits shall continue in
10 full force and effect notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 53.12.260
11 and 53.12.265.
