AN ACT Relating to professional salmon fishing guides; amending RCW 75.28.010; adding a new section to chapter 75.28 RCW; creating a new section; and repealing RCW 77.12.480.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 75.28.010 and 1985 c 457 s 18 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) Except as otherwise provided by this title, a license or permit
8 issued by the director is required to:

- 9 (a) Commercially fish for or take food fish or shellfish;
- 10 (b) Deliver food fish or shellfish taken in offshore waters;

11 (c) Operate a charter boat; ((or))

(d) Engage in processing or wholesaling food fish or shellfish; or
(e) Operate as a guide for salmon for personal use in freshwater
rivers and streams, other than that part of the Columbia river below
the bridge at Longview.

1 (2) It is unlawful to engage in the activities described in 2 subsection (1) of this section without having in possession the 3 licenses or permits required by this title.

4 (3) No license or permit is required for the production or harvesting of private sector cultured aquatic products as defined in 5 б RCW 15.85.020 or for the delivery, processing, or wholesaling of such aquatic products. However, if a means of identifying such products is 7 required by rules adopted under RCW 15.85.060, the exemption from 8 9 licensing or permit requirements established by this subsection applies only if the aquatic products are identified in conformance with those 10 11 rules.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 75.28 RCW 13 to read as follows:

14 A professional salmon guide license is required for the holder to offer or perform the services of a professional salmon guide in the 15 16 taking of salmon for personal use in freshwater rivers and streams, other than in that part of the Columbia river below the bridge at 17 18 Longview. The annual license fees are fifty dollars for residents and 19 five hundred dollars for nonresidents. A surcharge of twenty dollars shall be assessed on each resident guide license and a surcharge of one 20 hundred dollars shall be assessed on each nonresident guide license for 21 22 the purposes of RCW 75.50.100.

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The house fisheries and wildlife committee 24 and the senate committee on environment and natural resources shall 25 evaluate whether the fishing guide license requirements under this act 26 are sufficient, and shall present their recommendations to the 27 legislature by December 31, 1991.
