Brief Description: Expanding the jurisdiction of the human rights commission.

**HB 1443-S - DIGEST**

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 1/27/94)

Expands the jurisdiction of the human rights commission to include practices of discrimination because of a person's sexual orientation.

Does not require an employer to establish employment goals or quotas based on sexual orientation.

Gives the commission the same administrative remedies that are available to federal agencies.
