(2) Any parent or legal guardian who chooses to withdraw his
or her child from a class, activity, or service shall make the
request in writing or in person to the school district or school.

17 (3) Removal of a child by the parent shall in no way
18 eliminate the responsibility of the parent to provide for the
19 basic education of a child as required in 28A.150 RCW.

20 (4) Each school district shall annually notify the parents
21 or guardians of children enrolled in the school district of the
22 rights granted in subsection (1).

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The state board of education shall 24 provide school districts a model form that may be used by school 25 districts to notify parents and guardians of the rights granted 26 in section one of this act."

27 Correct the title accordingly.

EFFECT: Gives parents the right to remove their child from a class activity or service if it is objectionable based on personal, academic, moral or religious beliefs. Strikes sections 2 through 7.
