- 7 "Sec. 7. RCW 26.19.080 and 1990 1st ex.s. c 2 s 7 are each amended 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (1) The basic child support obligation derived from the economic 10 table shall be allocated between the parents based on each parent's 11 share of the combined monthly net income.
- (2) Ordinary health care expenses are included in the economic table. ((Monthly)) Health care expenses that exceed five percent of the basic support obligation for each calendar year after entry of the support order, or proportion thereof for orders beginning or ending mid-year, shall be considered extraordinary health care expenses.
- 17 Extraordinary health care expenses shall be shared by the parents in 18 the same proportion as the basic child support obligation.
- 19 (3) Day care and special child rearing expenses, such as tuition 20 and long-distance transportation costs to and from the parents for 21 visitation purposes, are not included in the economic table. These 22 expenses shall be shared by the parents in the same proportion as the 23 basic child support obligation.
- 24 (4) The court may exercise its discretion to determine the 25 necessity for and the reasonableness of all amounts ordered in excess 26 of the basic child support obligation."
