- 6 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 62. The legislature finds that property owners 7 often hire property management companies to manage their real property.
- 8 Frequently, the property management companies also manage the personnel
- 9 who perform the necessary services at the property location. The
- 10 property management company is merely acting as a conduit for the
- 11 property owner's payment to the personnel at the property site.
- 12 Section 63 of this act is intended to clarify that the business and
- 13 occupation tax does not apply to amounts received by a property
- 14 management company and paid to on-site personnel. Section 63 of this
- 15 act is not intended to modify the taxation of amounts received by a
- 16 property management company for purposes other than payment to on-site
- 17 personnel.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 63.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW
- 19 to read as follows:
- This chapter shall not apply to amounts received by a property
- 21 management company from the owner of a property for gross wages and
- 22 benefits paid to or on behalf of on-site personnel if the on-site
- 23 personnel are paid through use of trust accounts, dedicated bank
- 24 accounts, or paymaster accounts established for this purpose by the
- 25 property management company. As used in this section, "on-site
- 26 personnel" means a person who meets all of the following conditions:
- 27 (1) The person works at the owner's property; (2) the person's duties
- 28 include leasing property units, maintaining the property, collecting
- 29 rents, or similar activities; and (3) pursuant to a written property
- 30 management agreement, the person's compensation is the obligation of
- 31 the property owner and not the property manager."
- 32 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any internal
- 33 references accordingly.
