16	On page 3, after " <u>the facility.</u> " on line 6, insert " <u>The notice</u>
17	shall indicate that conversations between an inmate and a member of
18	the inmate's immediate family while the family member is visiting
19	at the facility cannot be intercepted, recorded, or divulged."

EFFECT: The Department of Corrections' authorization to intercept, record or divulge conversations occurring at a DOC facility is limited so that DOC cannot intercept, record or divulge conversations occurring during an in-facility visit between an inmate and a member of the inmate's immediate family. "Immediate family" means the inmate's spouse, children, stepchildren, grandchildren, great grandchildren, parents, stepparents, grandparents, great grandparents, and siblings.
