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On page 2, beginning on line 15, after "agencies." strike all 5 material through "vendors." on line 26, and insert "The task force 6 shall have eighteen members, twelve of whom are legislative members. 7 The legislative members of the task force shall be composed of the 8 9 following twelve members: The speaker of the house of representatives or the speaker's designated representative and the president of the 10 president's 11 or the designated representative; senate three 12 representatives from the majority caucus in the house of 13 representatives to be appointed by the speaker of the house of 14 representatives and three representatives from the majority caucus of the senate to be appointed by the president; and two representatives 15 16 from the minority caucus in the house of representatives to be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and two 17 representatives from the minority caucus in the senate to be appointed 18 The governor shall appoint the six remaining 19 by the president. 20 members, one of whom shall be designated chair with approval of the 21 speaker of the house of representatives and the president of the 22 senate. The gubernatorial appointees may include individuals served by the department of social and health services as clients and individuals 23 24 within the department of social and health services performing 25 caseworker or first-level supervisory functions as well as contractors 26 and vendors. The gubernatorial appointees shall serve at the pleasure 27 of the governor. Staffing for the task force shall be provided by the house office of program research and senate committee services." 28

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
