- 3 (c) Projected or actual direct lumber and wood products job losses 4 of one hundred positions or more;
- 5 (d) Projected or actual direct commercial salmon fishing job losses 6 of one hundred positions or more; and
- 7 (e) An unemployment rate twenty percent or more above the state 8 average. The counties that meet these criteria shall be determined by 9 the employment security department for the most recent year for which 10 data is available. For the purposes of administration of programs under this chapter, the United States post office five-digit zip code 11 delivery areas will be used to determine residence status for 12 13 eligibility purposes. For the purpose of this definition, a zip code delivery area that is located wholly or partially in an urbanized area 14 or within two miles of an urbanized area is considered urbanized. 15 16 office of financial management shall make available a zip code listing 17 of the areas to all agencies and organizations providing services under this chapter. 18

The public works board may require other terms and conditions and may charge such rates of interest on its loans as it deems appropriate to carry out the purposes of this section. Repayments shall be made to the public works assistance account.
