5 On page 1, after line 6, strike all material through "by law." on 6 line 17, and insert the following:

7 "If a court, during a judicial proceeding under this title relating 8 to a parenting plan or child custody, finds by a preponderance of the evidence that a person has intentionally made a false allegation of 9 child abuse or neglect or has induced another person to make a false 10 11 allegation of child abuse or neglect during the judicial proceeding, the court may impose a monetary penalty not to exceed one thousand 12 13 dollars against the person making or inducing another to make the The monetary penalty shall be awarded to the person 14 against whom the false allegation is made. When the court imposes the 15 monetary penalty, the court may also provide that reasonable attorneys' 16 17 fees may be imposed if the person entitled to the monetary penalty 18 incurs attorneys' fees to recover the penalty. The award may be enforced in the same manner as other civil judgments. A "person" means 19 a witness, a party, or a party's attorney. 20

21 The remedy provided by this section is in addition to any other 22 remedy provided by law.

This section shall not apply to unemancipated minors."

24 <u>EFFECT:</u> The provision is restructured to more clearly provide that 25 the court may make this finding during the actual proceeding in which 26 the allegation is made rather than in a different proceeding. This may 27 clarify that this section is not intended to be a civil action in tort 28 for damages arising from the false allegation.
