- 2 educated in private, parochial, and home-based instruction; and adding
- 3 a new section to chapter 28A.200 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.200 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Private, parochial, and home-based instruction students are
- 8 entitled to all the benefits of the certificate of mastery upon
- 9 successfully passing the standardized test or an academic knowledge-
- 10 based objective test selected by the private or parochial school or the
- 11 parent of the home-based instruction student if the test meets the
- 12 requirement of RCW 28A.200.010(3) in effect on July 25, 1993.
- 13 (2) Private, parochial, and home-based instruction students shall
- 14 not be denied equal access or opportunities to any benefit or benefits
- 15 provided by the certificate of mastery obtained in the public schools
- 16 of this state.
