
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 8406

1 WHEREAS, Association with the Washington State Legislature, as a
2 Senator or a Representative, in a staff position, as a lobbyist, or
3 through a news media assignment, forges a strong bond of personal
4 relationship among those who have shared this experience; and

5 WHEREAS, These long-standing legislative relationships have been
6 maintained through a biennial gathering, originated informally, known
7 as the "Old Timers" Reunion; and

8 WHEREAS, Perpetuating this common interest, and preserving the
9 traditions of public and professional service on which it is based,
10 strengthens the legislative process and contributes to the
11 institutional integrity of the legislature;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate, the House of
13 Representatives concurring, That there shall be a "Legislative Old
14 Timers" Reunion and related events planned and conducted Thursday,
15 February 27, 1997, as a formal and official program of this legislative
16 session; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That each caucus of the Senate and the
18 House of Representatives designate a member to form a committee which
19 shall be responsible for facilitating such a purpose with the enlisted
20 assistance of other active and former legislators, staff members,
21 lobbyists, and news people so that the Legislative Old Timers program

1 will provide a permanent connection of the past with the present for
2 the betterment of the State of Washington.
