SB 5158-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Declares an intent to modify the state's tax and child-care policies by allowing a credit against the tax liability of an employer who voluntarily participates in expansion of workplace child care and provide incentives to the private sector to: (1) Promote growth of employment opportunities;

- (2) assist employees in obtaining affordable high-quality child care;
- (3) increase opportunities for children to obtain early education and social skills; and
 - (4) reduce public assistance caseloads.
