Brief Title: Providing K-12 public education property tax credits.

SB 6283 - DIGEST

Allows a credit for taxes paid in the following amounts: (1) An amount equal to that portion of the taxpayer's property taxes designated for K-12 public education up to the amount of the taxpayer's contribution to a private school of the taxpayer's choice located within the county of the taxpayer's residence.

Provides that, if the taxpayer is a parent who through conscientious objection has elected to home school the taxpayer's children, an amount equal to that portion of the taxpayer's property taxes designated for K-12 public education up to the amount that taxpayer expended for the education of the taxpayer's children.
