1 AN ACT Relating to sales and use taxes to support state parks;
2 amending RCW 82.08.020; adding a new section to chapter 43.135 RCW;
3 providing an effective date; and providing for submission of this act
4 to vote of the people.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.08.020 and 1998 c 321 s 36 (Referendum Bill No. 49)
7 are each amended to read as follows:

8 (1) There is levied and there shall be collected a tax on each
9 retail sale in this state equal to six and five-tenths percent of the
10 selling price.

11 (2) There is levied and there shall be collected an additional tax
12 on each retail car rental, regardless of whether the vehicle is
13 licensed in this state, equal to five and nine-tenths percent of the
14 selling price. The revenue collected under this subsection shall be
15 deposited and distributed in the same manner as motor vehicle excise
16 tax revenue collected under RCW 82.44.020(1).

17 (3) There is levied and there shall be collected a tax on each
18 retail sale in this state equal to one-tenth percent of the selling
19 price. The tax shall be credited against the tax imposed under

1 subsection (1) of this section. The revenue collected under this
2 subsection shall be deposited in the parks renewal and stewardship
3 account.

4 (4) The taxes imposed under this chapter shall apply to successive
5 retail sales of the same property.

6 ((4)) (5) The rates provided in this section apply to taxes
7 imposed under chapter 82.12 RCW as provided in RCW 82.12.020.

8 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.135 RCW
9 to read as follows:

10 RCW 43.135.035(4) does not apply to RCW 82.08.020(3).

11 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act takes effect January 1, 2001.

12 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The secretary of state shall submit this act
13 to the people for their adoption and ratification, or rejection, at the
14 next general election to be held in this state, in accordance with
15 Article II, section 1 of the state Constitution and the laws adopted to
16 facilitate its operation.

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
