TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE W. BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, 1 AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF 2 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 3 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED, AND TO THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT 4 AND BUDGET, AND TO THE HONORABLE SPENCER ABRAHAM, SECRETARY OF THE 5 6 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY, AND TO STEVEN WRIGHT, ADMINISTRATOR 7 OF THE BONNEVILLE POWER ADMINISTRATION, AND TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF THE CONSUMER-OWNED UTILITIES AND THE 8 INVESTOR-OWNED UTILITIES SERVED BY THE BONNEVILLE POWER ADMINISTRATION: 9 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of 10 11 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully 12 represent and petition as follows:

13 WHEREAS, Power purchase contracts between the Bonneville Power 14 Administration and its customers allow the implementation of a Safety 15 Net Cost Recovery Adjustment Clause (SN CRAC) rate increase in any 16 fiscal year in which BPA has less than a fifty percent probability of 17 making its annual treasury payment; and

18 WHEREAS, The Bonneville Power Administration projects a greater 19 than eighty percent probability of making the treasury payment in 20 fiscal year 2004; and 1 WHEREAS, The Bonneville Power Administration implemented a SN CRAC 2 rate increase in fiscal year 2004 during an uncertain financial 3 situation that has since improved considerably; and

WHEREAS, The entire Pacific Northwest region would see significant economic benefits if the Bonneville Power Administration rolls back to zero the SN CRAC rate increase for fiscal year 2004;

7 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the 8 Bonneville Power Administration roll back to zero the fiscal year 2004 9 SN CRAC rate increase, so that business, industrial, small farm, and 10 residential customers throughout the Pacific Northwest region may enjoy 11 the economic benefits provided by electric rate relief.

12 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately 13 transmitted to the Honorable George W. Bush, President of the United 14 States, the Office of Management and Budget, the Honorable Spencer Abraham, Secretary of the United States Department of Energy, Steven 15 Wright, Administrator of the Bonneville Power Administration, the 16 17 honorable members of the Boards of Directors of the consumer-owned utilities and the investor-owned utilities served by the Bonneville 18 Power Administration, the President of the United States Senate, the 19 Speaker of the House of Representatives, and each member of Congress 20 21 from the State of Washington.
