- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 13.40 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The legislature finds that parents have a fundamental interest 8 in knowing if their child has been taken into police custody for 9 questioning and where their child is being held.
- (2) When a law enforcement officer takes a juvenile into custody, a reasonable attempt must be made to notify a parent, guardian, or custodian that the juvenile is in custody and where the juvenile is
- 13 being held.
