- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 3
- **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.95M.115 and 2006 c 231 s 2 are each amended to read 4 5 as follows:
- (1) Beginning July 1, 2007, a person who is known to be pregnant or 7 who is under three years of age shall not be vaccinated with a mercury-containing vaccine or injected with a mercury-containing product that contains more than 0.5 micrograms of mercury per 0.5 10 milliliter dose.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, an influenza 11 12 vaccine may contain up to 1.0 micrograms of mercury per 0.5 milliliter 13 dose.
- 14 (3) The secretary of the department of health may, upon declaration of ((a public health emergency)) an outbreak of vaccine-preventable 15 16 disease, suspend the requirements of this section for the duration of

17 the ((emergency)) outbreak.
