AN ACT Relating to providing retirement benefits at earlier ages in 1 2 the plans 2 and 3 of the public employees' retirement system, the 3 teachers' retirement system, and the school employees' retirement system; amending RCW 41.40.630, 41.40.820, 41.32.765, 4 41.32.875, 41.35.420, and 41.35.680; providing an effective date; and declaring en 5 6 emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- 8 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.40.630 and 2000 c 247 s 901 are each amended to 9 read as follows:
 - (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member with at least five service credit years who has attained at least age sixty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.620.
- (2) UNREDUCED RETIREMENT. Any member who is at least age fifty-14 15 five and has completed at least five service credit years and for whom 16 the sum of the number of years of the member's age and the number of 17 years of the member's service credit equals eighty-five or more shall be eligible to retire and receive a retirement allowance computed 18 according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.620.

- (3) EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least twenty service credit years and has attained age fifty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.620, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement allowance actuarially reduced to reflect the difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five.
- $((\frac{3}{1}))$ (4) ALTERNATE EARLY RETIREMENT. 8 Any member who has completed at least thirty service credit years and has attained age 9 fifty-five shall be eliqible to retire and to receive a retirement 10 allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.620, except 11 that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the 12 13 retirement allowance reduced by three percent per year to reflect the 14 difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five. 15
- 16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 41.40.820 and 2006 c 33 s 3 are each amended to read 17 as follows:
- 18 (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member who is at least age sixty-five and who has:
 - (a) Completed ten service credit years; or

- 21 (b) Completed five service credit years, including twelve service 22 credit months after attaining age forty-four; or
 - (c) Completed five service credit years by the transfer payment date specified in RCW 41.40.795, under the public employees' retirement system plan 2 and who transferred to plan 3 under RCW 41.40.795;
- shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.790.
 - (2) <u>UNREDUCED RETIREMENT</u>. Any member who is at least age fifty-five and has completed the number of service credit years required in subsection (1) of this section and for whom the sum of the number of years of the member's age and the number of years of the member's service credit equals eighty-five or more shall be eligible to retire and receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.790.
- 35 <u>(3)</u> EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has attained at least age 36 fifty-five and has completed at least ten years of service shall be 37 eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed

according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.790, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement allowance actuarially reduced to reflect the difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five.

- ((+3+)) (4) ALTERNATE EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least thirty service credit years and has attained age fifty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.790, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement allowance reduced by three percent per year to reflect the difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five.
- **Sec. 3.** RCW 41.32.765 and 2000 c 247 s 902 are each amended to read as follows:
 - (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member with at least five service credit years of service who has attained at least age sixty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.32.760.
 - (2) <u>UNREDUCED RETIREMENT</u>. Any member who is at least age fifty-five and has completed at least five service credit years and for whom the sum of the number of years of the member's age and the number of years of the member's service credit equals eighty-five or more shall be eligible to retire and receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.32.760.
 - (3) EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least twenty service credit years of service who has attained at least age fifty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.32.760, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement allowance actuarially reduced to reflect the difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five.
 - $((\frac{3}{3}))$ $\underline{(4)}$ ALTERNATE EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least thirty service credit years and has attained age fifty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.32.760, except

- 7 (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member who is at least age sixty-five 8 and who has:
 - (a) Completed ten service credit years; or
- 10 (b) Completed five service credit years, including twelve service 11 credit months after attaining age forty-four; or
- 12 (c) Completed five service credit years by July 1, 1996, under plan 13 2 and who transferred to plan 3 under RCW 41.32.817;
- shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.32.840.
 - (2) <u>UNREDUCED RETIREMENT</u>. - (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member with at least five service credit years who has attained at least age sixty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.35.400.
- (2) <u>UNREDUCED RETIREMENT</u>. Any member who is at least age fifty-five and has completed at least five service credit years and for whom the sum of the number of years of the member's age and the number of years of the member's service credit equals eighty-five or more shall be eligible to retire and receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.35.400.
- (3) EARLY RETIREMENT. - 35 (b) Completed five service credit years, including twelve service 36 credit months after attaining age forty-four; or

1 (c) Completed five service credit years by September 1, 2000, under 2 the public employees' retirement system plan 2 and who transferred to 3 plan 3 under RCW 41.35.510;

- shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.35.620.
- (2) <u>UNREDUCED RETIREMENT</u>. Any member who is at least age fifty-five and has completed the number of service credit years required in subsection (1) of this section and for whom the sum of the number of years of the member's age and the number of years of the member's service credit equals eighty-five or more shall be eliqible to retire and receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.35.620.
- (3) EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has attained at least age fifty-five and has completed at least ten years of service shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.35.620, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement allowance actuarially reduced to reflect the difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five.
- ((+3+)) (4) ALTERNATE EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least thirty service credit years and has attained age fifty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.35.620, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement allowance reduced by three percent per year to reflect the difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect July 1, 2007.
