- 1 AN ACT Relating to medicaid coverage for youth temporarily placed
- 2 in juvenile detention; adding a new section to chapter 74.09 RCW; and
- 3 creating a new section.

State of Washington

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that youth temporarily
- 6 detained in county detention facilities are often in need of medical or
- 7 mental health services. The legislature intends to use an opportunity
- 8 in federal law to provide medicaid funded services for medicaid
- 9 eligible youth temporarily detained in these facilities.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 74.09 RCW
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 In determining payment for services under medicaid, Title XIX of
- 13 the federal social security act, the department shall interpret 42
- 14 C.F.R. 435.1008 and 42 C.F.R. 435.1009 to allow payment for services on
- 15 behalf of a medicaid enrolled youth who is temporarily placed in a
- 16 juvenile detention facility. Temporary placement shall be defined as

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- 1 until adjudication or up to sixty continuous days, whichever occurs
- 2 first.

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
