- AN ACT Relating to volunteer hospice care centers; and amending RCW
- 2 18.20.030 and 70.128.030.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.20.030 and 2004 c 142 s 17 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) After January 1, 1958, no person shall operate or maintain a 7 boarding home as defined in this chapter within this state without a 8 license under this chapter.
- 9 (2) A boarding home license is not required for the housing, or 10 services, that are customarily provided under landlord tenant agreements governed by the residential landlord-tenant act, chapter 11 12 59.18 RCW, or when housing nonresident individuals who, without ongoing assistance from the boarding home, initiate and arrange for services 13 provided by persons other than the boarding home licensee or the 14 15 licensee's contractor. This subsection does not prohibit the licensee from furnishing written information concerning available community 16 resources to the nonresident individual or the individual's family 17 members or legal representatives. The licensee may not require the use 18

19 of any particular service provider.

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1 (3) Residents receiving domiciliary care, directly or indirectly by 2 the boarding home, are not considered nonresident individuals for the 3 purposes of this section.

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- (4) A boarding home license is required when any person other than an outside service provider, under RCW 18.20.380, or family member:
- 6 (a) Assumes general responsibility for the safety and well-being of a resident;
- 8 (b) Provides assistance with activities of daily living, either 9 directly or indirectly;
- 10 (c) Provides health support services, either directly or 11 indirectly; or
- 12 (d) Provides intermittent nursing services, either directly or 13 indirectly.
- 14 (5) A boarding home license is not required for one or more of the following services that may be provided to a nonresident individual: 15 (a) Emergency assistance provided on an intermittent or nonroutine 16 17 basis to any nonresident individual; (b) systems employed by independent senior housing, or independent living units in continuing 18 care retirement communities, to respond to the potential need for 19 emergency services for nonresident individuals; (c) infrequent, 20 21 voluntary, and nonscheduled blood pressure checks for nonresident 22 individuals; (d) nurse referral services provided at the request of a nonresident individual to determine whether referral to an outside 23 24 health care provider is recommended; (e) making health 25 request of nonresident individuals; appointments at the (f) preadmission assessment, at the request of the nonresident individual, 26 27 for the purposes of transitioning to a licensed care setting; or (g) services customarily provided under landlord tenant agreements governed 28 by the residential landlord-tenant act, chapter 59.18 RCW. 29 preceding services may not include continual care or supervision of a 30 31 nonresident individual without a boarding home license.
- (6) A boarding home license is not required for a volunteer hospice
 care center that is exempt under RCW 70.127.050 from licensing
 requirements under chapter 70.127 RCW.
- 35 **Sec. 2.** RCW 70.128.030 and 1989 c 427 s 17 are each amended to read as follows:

2	operation of this chapter:
3	(1) Nursing homes licensed under chapter 18.51 RCW;
4	(2) Boarding homes licensed under chapter 18.20 RCW;
5	(3) Facilities approved and certified under chapter 71A.22 RCW;
6	(4) Residential treatment centers for ((the)) persons who are
7	mentally ill licensed under chapter 71.24 RCW;
8	(5) Hospitals licensed under chapter 70.41 RCW;

(6) Homes for ((the)) persons who are developmentally disabled 9 licensed under chapter 74.15 RCW; 10

(7) Volunteer hospice care centers that are exempt under RCW 11 70.127.050 from licensing requirements under chapter 70.127 RCW. 12

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
