1 AN ACT Relating to requiring the state parks and recreation 2 commission to fully plan for potential future impacts at Saint Edward 3 state park; creating new sections; and providing an expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds Bastyr University, a nonprofit, private university, is located adjacent to Saint Edward 6 The legislature also recognizes the fact that Bastyr 7 state park. 8 University has recently adopted a twenty-five-year campus master plan that outlines significant growth for the university over the next few 9 decades. Growth of both the university's enrollment and physical size 10 will have an impact on the neighboring Saint Edward state park. 11 The 12 legislature finds that the state parks and recreation commission should work with Bastyr University and complete necessary planning to address 13 14 the potential future impact on Saint Edward state park that may arise 15 from the planned expansion of Bastyr University.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. (1) The state parks and recreation 17 commission shall initiate and complete an in-depth review and full 18 planning process to address the immediate and long-term potential 1 future impacts to Saint Edward state park arising from the planned 2 expansion of Bastyr University. The planning process must, at a 3 minimum, consider the impacts on:

(a) Traffic in and around the park, including all access roads;

5 (b) Emergency vehicle access;

6 (c) Parking in the park;

7 (d) The adequacy of the park's utilities;

8 (e) The impacts of increased use of the facilities, including the 9 swimming pool, the gymnasium, the sports field, the great lawn, and 10 hiking and biking trails; and

11 (f) The impacts of increased use on the flora and fauna of the 12 park.

13 (2) The review conducted under this section must also consider the 14 utility of and barriers to a cost-sharing agreement between the state 15 parks and recreation commission and Bastyr University to financially 16 aid the park in the execution of the plan developed under this section.

17 (3) The documents required by this section must be completed and 18 reported to the appropriate committees of the legislature by January 1, 19 2008. Prior to the final adoption of the required documents, the state 20 parks and recreation commission shall conduct at least one public 21 hearing on the draft documents in a community near Saint Edward state 22 park.

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This act expires July 31, 2008.
