- $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION.}}$ Sec. 1. (1) It is unlawful for a person to
- 6 intentionally kill or harm a horse or cattle belonging to another
- 7 person, without consent of the owner. A violation of this section
- 8 constitutes a class B felony.
- 9 (2) This section does not apply to individuals meeting the
- 10 definition of slaughterer or packer, as those terms are defined in RCW
- 11 16.50.110, when conducting activities consistent with those
- 12 definitions.
- 13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 4.24.320 and 2005 c 419 s 2 are each amended to read
- 14 as follows:
- 15 Any person who suffers damage to livestock as a result of actions
- 16 described in RCW 16.52.205 or any owner of livestock who suffers damage
- 17 as a result of a willful, unauthorized act described in RCW 9A.56.080
- 18 ((or)), 9A.56.083, or section 1 of this act may bring an action against

- 1 the person or persons committing the act in a court of competent
- 2 jurisdiction for exemplary damages up to three times the actual damages
- 3 sustained, plus attorney's fees. As used in this section, "livestock"
- 4 means the animals specified in RCW 9A.56.080.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Section 1 of this act constitutes a new
- 6 chapter in Title 16 RCW.
