- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.14 RCW to read as follows:
- An individual applying for health services through the health care authority or the department of social and health services shall provide one of the following forms of identification the first time he or she applies:
- 10 (1) Valid photo identification issued by the department of 11 licensing;
- 12 (2) A valid enrollment card of a federally recognized Indian tribe 13 in Washington state; or
- 14 (3) A government document that shows both the name and address of the individual.
