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- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.70.670 and 2003 c 274 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) "Human immunodeficiency virus insurance program," as used in this section, means a program that provides health insurance coverage for individuals with human immunodeficiency virus, as defined in RCW 70.24.017(7), who are not eligible for medical assistance programs from the department of social and health services as defined in RCW 74.09.010(8) and meet eligibility requirements established by the
- 13 (2) The department of health may pay for health insurance coverage 14 on behalf of persons with human immunodeficiency virus, who meet 15 department eligibility requirements, and who are eligible for 16 "continuation coverage" as provided by the federal consolidated omnibus 17 budget reconciliation act of 1985, group health insurance policies, or
- 18 individual policies. ((The number of insurance policies supported by

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- 1 this program in the Washington state health insurance pool as defined
- 2 in RCW 48.41.030(18) shall not grow beyond the July 1, 2003, level.))

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
