1 AN ACT Relating to providing assistance to homeless individuals and 2 families; adding new sections to chapter 43.185C RCW; and making 3 appropriations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.185C 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) The transitional housing operating and rent program is created 8 in the department to assist homeless individuals and families secure and retain safe, decent, and affordable housing. For the purposes of 9 the transitional housing operating and rent program, the department 10 shall develop program eligibility criteria that includes, but is not 11 12 limited to, the definition of homeless person in RCW 43.185C.010, and shall also take into consideration factors that contribute to or 13 precipitate homelessness including, but not limited to, domestic 14 15 violence. The department shall provide grants to eliqible organizations, as described in RCW 43.185.060, to provide assistance to 16 program participants. The eligible organizations must use grant moneys 17 18 for:

(a) Rental assistance, which includes security or utility deposits,
 first and last month's rent assistance, and eligible moving expenses to
 be determined by the department;

4 (b) Case management services designed to assist program
5 participants to secure and retain immediate housing and to transition
6 into permanent housing and greater levels of self-sufficiency;

7 (c) Operating expenses of transitional housing facilities that 8 serve homeless families with children; and

9 (d) Administrative costs of the eligible organization, which must 10 not exceed limits prescribed by the department.

11 (2) Eligible to receive assistance through the transitional housing 12 operating and rent program are:

(a) Families with children who are homeless or who are at risk of
becoming homeless and who have household incomes at or below fifty
percent of the median household income for their county; and

(b) Individuals or families without children who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless and who have household incomes at or below thirty percent of the median household income for their county.

(3) All program participants must be willing to create and actively
 participate in a housing stability plan for achieving permanent housing
 and greater levels of self-sufficiency.

(4) Data on all program participants must be entered into and
 tracked through the Washington homeless client management information
 system as described in RCW 43.185C.180.

25 (5) The department encourages all eligible organizations funded through the program to have a quality management system and to submit 26 27 an application to the Washington state quality award program to Beginning in 2009, all organizations funded evaluate that system. 28 through the program receiving over five hundred thousand dollars a year 29 during the previous calendar year from: This program; other state 30 housing related funding sources, including the housing trust fund; 31 32 housing finance commission programs; and the ending homelessness program surcharge in RCW 36.22.179 and the surcharges in RCW 36.22.178, 33 shall apply to the full examination Washington state quality award 34 program once every three years beginning by January 1, 2010. 35

(6) The department may develop rules, requirements, procedures, and
 guidelines as necessary to implement and operate the transitional
 housing operating and rent program.

(7) The department shall produce an annual transitional housing 1 2 operating and rent program report that must be included in the homeless housing strategic plan as 3 department's described in The report must include performance measures to be 4 43.185C.040. 5 determined by the department that address, at a minimum, the following issue areas: 6

7 (a) The success of the program in helping program participants 8 transition into permanent housing and increase their levels of self-9 sufficiency;

10 (b) The financial performance of the program related to efficient 11 program administration by the department and program operation by 12 selected eligible organizations, including an analysis of the costs per 13 program participant served;

14 (c) The quality, completeness, and timeliness of the information on 15 program participants provided to the Washington homeless client 16 management information system database; and

17 (d) The satisfaction of program participants in the assistance18 provided through the program.

19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.185C
20 RCW to read as follows:

21 The transitional housing operating and rent account is created in the custody of the state treasurer. All receipts from sources directed 22 23 to the transitional housing operating and rent program must be 24 deposited into the account. Expenditures from the account may be used solely for the purpose of the transitional housing operating and rent 25 26 program as described in section 1 of this act. Only the director of 27 the department or the director's designee may authorize expenditures from the account. The account is subject to allotment procedures under 28 chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not required for 29 30 expenditures.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) The sum of seven million five hundred thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, from the general fund to the transitional housing operating and rent account created in section 2 of this act for the purpose of implementing and operating the transitional housing operating and rent program. The first two million

five hundred dollars of the appropriation shall be distributed to 1 eligible organizations that will utilize available funds, less 2 appropriate administrative costs of the department of community, trade, 3 and economic development, to be used for the purposes described in 4 section 1(1) (a) through (d) of this act solely to serve families with 5 children under the age of eighteen. All remaining appropriated moneys, б 7 less appropriate administrative costs of the department of community, trade, and economic development, shall be used solely for the purposes 8 described in section 1(1) (a), (b), and (d) of this act to serve those 9 eligible under section 1(2) of this act. 10

11 (2) The sum of seven million five hundred thousand dollars, or as 12 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year 13 ending June 30, 2009, from the general fund to the transitional housing operating and rent account created in section 2 of this act for the 14 15 purpose of implementing and operating the transitional housing operating and rent program. The first two million five hundred dollars 16 of the appropriation shall be distributed to eligible organizations 17 that will utilize available funds, less appropriate administrative 18 costs of the department of community, trade, and economic development, 19 to be used for the purposes described in section 1(1) (a) through (d) 20 21 of this act solely to serve families with children under the age of 22 eighteen. All remaining appropriated moneys, less appropriate administrative costs of the department of community, trade, and 23 24 economic development, shall be used solely for the purposes described 25 in section 1(1) (a), (b), and (d) of this act to serve those eligible 26 under section 1(2) of this act.
