HOUSE BILL 1921

State of Washington 60th Legislature 2007 Regular Session

AN ACT Relating to providing assistance to homeless individuals and families; adding new sections to chapter 43.185C RCW; and making appropriations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.185C 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) The transitional housing operating and rent program is created 8 in the department to assist homeless individuals and families secure 9 and retain safe, decent, and affordable housing. The department shall 10 provide grants to eligible organizations, as described in RCW 11 43.185.060, to provide assistance to program participants. The 12 eligible organizations must use grant moneys for:

(a) Rental assistance, which includes security or utility deposits,
first and last month's rent assistance, and eligible moving expenses to
be determined by the department;

16 (b) Case management services designed to assist program 17 participants to secure and retain immediate housing and to transition 18 into permanent housing and greater levels of self-sufficiency; (c) Operating expenses of transitional housing facilities that
 serve homeless families with children; and

3 (d) Administrative costs of the eligible organization, which must4 not exceed limits prescribed by the department.

5 (2) Eligible to receive assistance through the transitional housing
6 operating and rent program are:

7 (a) Families with children who are homeless or who are at risk of
8 becoming homeless and who have household incomes at or below fifty
9 percent of the median household income for their county; and

10 (b) Individuals or families without children who are homeless or at 11 risk of becoming homeless and who have household incomes at or below 12 thirty percent of the median household income for their county.

(3) All program participants must be willing to create and actively
 participate in a housing stability plan for achieving permanent housing
 and greater levels of self-sufficiency.

(4) Data on all program participants must be entered into and
 tracked through the Washington homeless client management information
 system as described in RCW 43.185C.180.

19 (5) The department encourages eligible organizations funded through 20 the program to have a quality management system and to submit an 21 application to the Washington state quality award program to evaluate 22 that system.

(6) The department may develop rules, requirements, procedures, and
 guidelines as necessary to implement and operate the transitional
 housing operating and rent program.

(7) The department shall produce an annual transitional housing 26 27 operating and rent program report that must be included in the department's homeless housing 28 strategic plan as described in The report must include performance measures to be 29 43.185C.040. determined by the department that address, at a minimum, the following 30 31 issue areas:

(a) The success of the program in helping program participants
 transition into permanent housing and increase their levels of self sufficiency;

35 (b) The financial performance of the program related to efficient 36 program administration by the department and program operation by 37 selected eligible organizations, including an analysis of the costs per 38 program participant served;

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(c) The quality, completeness, and timeliness of the information on
 program participants provided to the Washington homeless client
 management information system database; and

4 (d) The satisfaction of program participants in the assistance5 provided through the program.

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.185C 7 RCW to read as follows:

The transitional housing operating and rent account is created in 8 9 the custody of the state treasurer. All receipts from sources directed to the transitional housing operating and rent program must be 10 11 deposited into the account. Expenditures from the account may be used 12 solely for the purpose of the transitional housing operating and rent program as described in section 1 of this act. Only the director of 13 the department or the director's designee may authorize expenditures 14 from the account. The account is subject to allotment procedures under 15 16 chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not required for 17 expenditures.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) The sum of seven million five hundred 18 19 thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is 20 appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, from the general fund to the transitional housing operating and rent account created in 21 22 section 2 of this act for the purpose of implementing and operating the 23 transitional housing operating and rent program. The first two million five hundred dollars of the appropriation shall be distributed to 24 eligible organizations that will utilize available funds, less 25 appropriate administrative costs of the department of community, trade, 26 and economic development, to be used for the purposes described in 27 section 1(1) (a) through (d) of this act solely to serve families with 28 children under the age of eighteen. All remaining appropriated moneys, 29 30 less appropriate administrative costs of the department of community, trade, and economic development, shall be used solely for the purposes 31 described in section 1(1) (a), (b), and (d) of this act to serve those 32 eligible under section 1(2) of this act. 33

(2) The sum of seven million five hundred thousand dollars, or as
 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year
 ending June 30, 2009, from the general fund to the transitional housing

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operating and rent account created in section 2 of this act for the 1 2 purpose of implementing and operating the transitional housing operating and rent program. The first two million five hundred dollars 3 of the appropriation shall be distributed to eligible organizations 4 that will utilize available funds, less appropriate administrative 5 costs of the department of community, trade, and economic development, б 7 to be used for the purposes described in section 1(1) (a) through (d) of this act solely to serve families with children under the age of 8 All remaining appropriated moneys, less appropriate 9 eighteen. administrative costs of the department of community, trade, and 10 economic development, shall be used solely for the purposes described 11 12 in section 1(1) (a), (b), and (d) of this act to serve those eligible 13 under section 1(2) of this act.

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
