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- AN ACT Relating to newborn screening fees; amending RCW 70.83.040;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 70.83 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.83.040 and 2005 c 518 s 938 are each amended to read as follows:
 - When notified of positive screening tests, the state department of health shall offer the use of its services and facilities, designed to prevent mental retardation or physical defects in such children, to the attending physician, or the parents of the newborn child if no attending physician can be identified.
- 11 The services and facilities of the department, and other state and 12 local agencies cooperating with the department in carrying out programs of detection and prevention of mental retardation and physical defects 13 shall be made available to the family and physician to the extent 14 required in order to carry out the intent of this chapter and within 15 the availability of funds. ((The department has the authority to 16 collect a reasonable fee, from the parents or other responsible party 17 of each infant screened to fund specialty clinics that provide 18 19 treatment services for hemoglobin diseases, phenylketonuria, congenital

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- 1 adrenal hyperplasia, congenital hypothyroidism, and, during the 2005-07
- 2 fiscal biennium, other disorders defined by the board of health under
- 3 RCW 70.83.020. The fee may be collected through the facility where the
- 4 screening specimen is obtained.))
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 70.83 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The department has the authority to collect the following fees from
- 8 the parents or other responsible party of each infant screened for
- 9 heritable or metabolic disorders as defined by the state board of
- 10 health under RCW 70.83.020:
- 11 (1) A fee for laboratory testing associated with newborn testing
- 12 for the defined disorders; and
- 13 (2) A fee of three dollars and fifty cents to fund specialty
- 14 clinics that provide treatment services for children with the defined
- 15 disorders.
- The fee may be collected through the facility where the screening
- 17 specimen is obtained.

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
