1 AN ACT Relating to improving the availability of motor vehicle fuel
2 in the event of an electric power outage or interruption in electric
3 service; adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW; providing an
4 effective date; and providing an expiration date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) In computing the tax imposed under this chapter, a credit is
9 allowed for the purchase of an alternative power generation device by
10 an eligible person. The credit is equal to the lesser of fifty percent
11 of the cost of the alternative power generation device or fifty
12 thousand dollars.

13 (2) The amount of the credit provided in subsection (1) of this
14 section may not exceed the tax otherwise due under this chapter for the
15 tax reporting period.

16 (3) The total amount of credits taken under this section in any
17 biennium may not exceed seven hundred fifty thousand dollars.

18 (4) The definitions in this subsection apply throughout this
19 section:

1 (a) "Alternative power generation device" means a device capable of
2 providing electrical power for gasoline service station pumps during
3 periods when regular electrical power is lost including, but not
4 limited to, portable generators, standby generators, emergency
5 generators, or other power generation devices.

6 (b) "Eligible person" means a person selling motor vehicle or
7 special fuel from a gasoline service station, or other facility, with
8 at least four fuel pumps.

9 (5) This section expires June 30, 2011.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect August 1, 2007.
