AN ACT Relating to requiring certain employees of the department of licensing to submit to a criminal background check if they have access to the personally identifying information of Washington residents; and adding a new section to chapter 41.06 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 41.06 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 (1) A person who is employed by the department of licensing in any 9 position that provides, grants, or allows access to personal 10 identifying information of another person who is a resident of this 11 state must successfully pass a criminal background check before being 12 placed in or continuing placement in such a position.

13 (2) For the purposes of this section, "personal identifying 14 information" means an individual's: (a) Social security number; (b) 15 driver's license number; (c) bank account number; (d) credit or debit 16 card number; (e) personal identification number; (f) automated or 17 electronic signature; (g) unique biometric data; (h) account passwords; 1 or (i) any other piece of information that can be used to access an 2 individual's financial accounts or to obtain goods or services.
