1 AN ACT Relating to early intervention services for children who are  
2 three years old; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The department of social and health services  
5 and the office of the superintendent of public instruction shall  
6 jointly confer and consult with appropriate entities, develop  
7 recommendations, and report back to the legislature by October 1, 2007,  
8 regarding a policy and process to ensure that children who are eligible  
9 for special education services under chapter 28A.155 RCW do not  
10 experience a gap in receiving services when transitioning out of infant  
11 and toddler early intervention programs upon reaching the age of three  
12 years.
