- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.83 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- The department may contact the parent or quardian of an infant who 7
- 8 fails a newborn hearing screening for the purpose of assisting the
- parent or guardian in obtaining a comprehensive hearing assessment for 9
- 10 the child. Contacts with parents and guardians under this section
- shall be consistent with procedures established pursuant to RCW 11
- 12 70.83.040.
- 13 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The legislature finds that the department of
- health plans to undertake a survey of selected parents and guardians 14
- 15 of infants who have failed a newborn hearing screening for the purpose
- of gathering more information about comprehensive hearing assessments 16
- The department shall, upon completion of its 17 for these newborns.
