- 1 AN ACT Relating to private residential fire sprinklers; and

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1)(a) The state building code council shall form a technical advisory group to research and review policies and procedures for residential fire sprinklers.
- 7 (b) The purpose of the study is to research obstacles and barriers 8 to the installation of residential fire sprinkler systems.
 - (2) The technical advisory group must consist of:
- 10 (a) Representatives from: A city association, a county
 11 association, the association of building officials, an association of
 12 special purpose water-sewer districts, and a public utility district
 13 association;
- 14 (b) A fire chief, a state licensed residential fire sprinkler 15 contractor, an architect, and a residential builder; and
- 16 (c) Any other representative deemed necessary to develop the model policy.
- 18 (3) The state building code council shall report the findings of
