HOUSE BILL 2310

State of Washington 60th Legislature 2007 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to the care of individuals with traumatic brain 2 injury; adding a new section to chapter 74.39 RCW; adding a new section 3 to chapter 72.23 RCW; and creating new sections.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. Individuals who have been diagnosed with a traumatic brain injury face many unique challenges. Some individuals 6 7 with traumatic brain injury have also been diagnosed with a mental 8 disorder that requires active psychiatric treatment at an inpatient 9 hospital level of care. Others who do not need active psychiatric 10 inpatient care have been placed in state institutions for lack of an 11 alternative care option. Such unnecessary placement diminishes the 12 lives of these individuals and prevents their ability to control the 13 direction of their lives.

14 Since 2001 the department of social and health services has 15 maintained an expanded community services program that has provided 16 community residential mental health and other services for long-term 17 state hospital residents who can be better cared for in the community. 18 The legislature finds that many individuals who have been diagnosed 19 with traumatic brain injury and do not have an accompanying mental 1 disorder that requires active psychiatric treatment at an inpatient 2 hospital level of care can be better cared for in these community 3 settings.

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 74.39 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The current expanded community services program is established 7 as a permanent program in the department of social and health services 8 aging and disability services administration.

9 (2) The department shall determine the appropriate individuals who 10 may participate in the expanded community services program. To the 11 extent of available funding, the individuals who shall be served by the 12 program include those that have been diagnosed with traumatic brain 13 injury and do not have an accompanying mental disorder that requires 14 active psychiatric treatment at an inpatient hospital level of care.

15 (3) The program shall provide enhanced community residential 16 support services and personal care for people whose treatment needs 17 constitute substantial barriers to community placement, and who no 18 longer require active psychiatric treatment in an inpatient hospital 19 setting.

(4) For the purposes of this section, "expanded community services
program" has the same meaning as in RCW 70.97.010.

22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 72.23 RCW 23 to read as follows:

As of January 1, 2008, any admission of new patients who are individuals who have been diagnosed with traumatic brain injury and do not have an accompanying mental disorder that requires active psychiatric treatment at an inpatient hospital level of care to a state hospital shall be limited to a length of time necessary to stabilize the individual and place him or her in an appropriate community setting.

31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. If specific funding for the purposes of this 32 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by 33 June 30, 2007, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and
