- AN ACT Relating to exempting certain amateur radio repeaters from 1
- 2 leasehold excise taxes; and adding a new section to chapter 82.29A RCW.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 3
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.29A RCW 4 5 to read as follows:
  - (1) Any leasehold interest in an amateur radio repeater, which is made available for use by, or is used in support of, a public agency in the event of an emergency or potential emergency to which the agency is, or may be, a qualified responder, is exempt from tax under this chapter or any similar tax imposed for the lease of public property.
  - (2) For purposes of this act, "amateur radio repeater" means an electronic device that receives a weak or low-level amateur radio signal and retransmits it at a higher level or higher power, so that the signal can cover longer distances without degradation, and is used by amateur radio operators possessing a valid license issued by the
