AN ACT Relating to funds subject to the state expenditure limit; amending RCW 43.135.025; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.135.025 and 2005 c 72 s 4 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) The state shall not expend from the general fund and related
8 funds during any fiscal year state moneys in excess of the state
9 expenditure limit established under this chapter.

10 (2) Except pursuant to a declaration of emergency under RCW 43.135.035 or pursuant to an appropriation under RCW 43.135.045(4)(b), 11 the state treasurer shall not issue or redeem any check, warrant, or 12 13 voucher that will result in a state general fund or related fund expenditure for any fiscal year in excess of the state expenditure 14 15 limit established under this chapter. A violation of this subsection 16 constitutes a violation of RCW 43.88.290 and shall subject the state 17 treasurer to the penalties provided in RCW 43.88.300.

18 (3) The state expenditure limit for any fiscal year shall be the

previous fiscal year's state expenditure limit increased by a
 percentage rate that equals the fiscal growth factor.

3 (4) For purposes of computing the state expenditure limit for the 4 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, the phrase "the previous fiscal 5 year's state expenditure limit" means the total state expenditures from 6 the state general fund and related funds, not including federal funds, 7 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, plus the fiscal growth 8 factor.

(5) A state expenditure limit committee is established for the 9 purpose of determining and adjusting the state expenditure limit as 10 provided in this chapter. The members of the state expenditure limit 11 12 committee are the director of financial management, the attorney 13 general or the attorney general's designee, and the chairs and ranking minority members of the senate committee on ways and means and the 14 house of representatives committee on appropriations. All actions of 15 the state expenditure limit committee taken pursuant to this chapter 16 17 require an affirmative vote of at least four members.

(6) Each November, the state expenditure limit committee shall 18 adjust the expenditure limit for the preceding fiscal year based on 19 actual expenditures and known changes in the fiscal growth factor and 20 21 then project an expenditure limit for the next two fiscal years. If, 22 by November 30th, the state expenditure limit committee has not adopted the expenditure limit adjustment and projected expenditure limit as 23 24 provided in subsection (5) of this section, the attorney general or his 25 or her designee shall adjust or project the expenditure limit, as necessary. 26

(7) "Fiscal growth factor" means the average growth in statepersonal income for the prior ten fiscal years.

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(8) "General fund" means the state general fund.

30 (9) "Related fund" means the health services account, violence 31 reduction and drug enforcement account, public safety and education 32 account, water quality account, <u>education legacy trust fund</u>, <u>pension</u> 33 <u>funding stabilization account</u>, or student achievement fund.

34 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 35 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
