- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 35.21 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) A municipal agency shall notify a property owner of a municipal agency's response to an emergency on property titled in the owner's name within twenty-four hours of the response by the municipal agency.
 - (2) For purposes of this section:

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 43.43 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) The Washington state patrol shall notify a property owner of the Washington state patrol's response to an emergency on property titled in the owner's name within twenty-four hours of the response by the Washington state patrol.
- 29 (2) For purposes of this section "emergency" means an incident that 30 requires a normal state patrol, coroner, fire, rescue, emergency 31 medical services, or utility response.
- 32 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 52.30 RCW 33 to read as follows:
- 34 (1) A fire protection district shall notify a property owner of a
