- 1 AN ACT Relating to operating a motor vehicle while smoking; adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 46.61 RCW; creating a new section; prescribing
- 3 penalties; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 6 to read as follows:
 - (1) A person who smokes a lighted pipe, cigar, or cigarette in a moving or parked motor vehicle containing any passengers under the age of eighteen years is guilty of a traffic infraction.
 - (2) Enforcement of this section by law enforcement officers may be accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation of this title or an equivalent local ordinance or some other offense.
- 14 (3) Infractions under this section shall not become part of the 15 driver's record under RCW 46.52.101 and 46.52.120. Additionally, a 16 finding that a person has committed a traffic infraction under this 17 section shall not be made available to insurance companies or 18 employers.
