- AN ACT Relating to prohibiting port districts from engaging in residential real estate development projects; and amending RCW
- 3 53.08.020, 53.08.080, 53.08.245, and 53.08.400.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 53.08.020 and 1963 c 147 s 3 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) A port district may construct, condemn, purchase, acquire, add 8 to, maintain, conduct, and operate sea walls, jetties, piers, wharves,
- 9 docks, boat landings, and other harbor improvements, warehouses,
- storehouses, elevators, grain-bins, cold storage plants, terminal icing
- 11 plants, bunkers, oil tanks, ferries, canals, locks, tidal basins,
- 12 bridges, subways, tramways, cableways, conveyors, administration
- 13 buildings, fishing terminals, together with modern appliances and
- 14 buildings for the economical handling, packaging, storing, and
- 15 transporting of freight and handling of passenger traffic, rail and
- 16 motor vehicle transfer and terminal facilities, water transfer and
- 17 terminal facilities, air transfer and terminal facilities, and any
- 18 combination of such transfer and terminal facilities, commercial
- 19 transportation, transfer, handling, storage and terminal facilities,

- district may lease all lands, wharves, docks and real and personal property owned and controlled by it, for such purposes and upon such terms as the port commission deems proper: PROVIDED, That no lease shall be for a period longer than fifty years with option for extensions for up to an additional thirty years, except where the property involved is or is to be devoted to airport purposes the port commission may lease said property for such period as may equal the
- 25 seventy-five years: PROVIDED FURTHER, That where the property is held

- engage in economic development programs. In addition, port districts may contract with nonprofit corporations in furtherance of this and other acts relating to economic development.
 - (2) The contracts authorized under this section do not include those relating to residential real estate development.

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- 6 **Sec. 4.** RCW 53.08.400 and 2002 c 218 s 27 are each amended to read 7 as follows:
- 8 (1) A port district may enter into a contract with any city, town, 9 or county for the purpose of exercising any powers of a community 10 renewal agency under chapter 35.81 RCW.
- 11 (2) The contracts authorized under this section do not include 12 those relating to residential real estate development.
