- agricultural structures are those that are designed and constructed to

- 10 horticultural products. Human habitation, public use, and employment
- 11 where agricultural products are processed, treated, or packaged are not
- 12 permitted uses of a specialty agricultural building. Specialty
- agricultural buildings shall not require a permit under this chapter, 13
- 14 but are subject to setback requirements established by the local
- 15 jurisdiction and utility easements. For the purposes of this section,
