- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.76 RCW 6 to read as follows:
  - (1) A person who knowingly makes a false or misleading material statement to a public servant that a child has been abducted and which statement causes the activation of the voluntary broadcast notification system commonly known as the "Amber alert," or as the same system may otherwise be known, which is used to notify the public of abducted children, is guilty of a class C felony.
- 13 (2) "Material statement" means a written or oral statement 14 reasonably likely to be relied upon by a public servant in the 15 discharge of his or her official powers or duties.
