- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.18 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The use of a person's credit history or credit score as a factor in
- 8 underwriting, renewal, cancellation, and premium decisions by insurers
- 9 for personal insurance is prohibited in this state.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The following acts or parts of acts are each
- 11 repealed:
- 12 (1) RCW 48.18.545 (Underwriting restrictions that apply to personal
- insurance--Credit history or insurance score--Rules) and 2002 c 360 s
- 14 1; and
- 15 (2) RCW 48.19.035 (Making of rates--Definitions--Personal
- 16 insurance--Use of credit history or insurance scores--Rules) and 2004
