- 1 AN ACT Relating to providing enhanced funding for crime victim 2 services and prosecutorial costs; adding a new section to chapter 43.31
- 3 RCW; and making an appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.31 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The department of community, trade, and economic development 8 shall establish a grant program to enhance the funding, treatment, and 9 services for victims of felony crimes and for enhanced local 10 prosecutorial costs.
- 11 (2) Funding may be used to build on efforts by existing community 12 programs, coordinating those efforts, or developing cooperating efforts 13 to make the most effective use of resources to provide services to 14 victims and to prosecute a greater number of felony cases.
- 15 (3) Funds shall be disbursed through a request for proposal 16 process.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of five hundred thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium
