- 1 AN ACT Relating to false and defamatory statements about candidates
- 2 for public office; and amending RCW 42.17.530.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.17.530 and 2005 c 445 s 10 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) It is a violation of this chapter for a person to sponsor with 7 actual malice:
 - (a) Political advertising or an electioneering communication that contains a false statement of material fact about a candidate for public office, and is defamatory with regard to that candidate. However, this subsection (1)(a) does not apply to statements made by a
- 12 candidate or the candidate's agent about the candidate himself or

- 14 (b) Political advertising or an electioneering communication that 15 falsely represents that a candidate is the incumbent for the office 16 sought when in fact the candidate is not the incumbent;
- 17 (c) Political advertising or an electioneering communication that 18 makes either directly or indirectly, a false claim stating or implying

- the support or endorsement of any person or organization when in fact the candidate does not have such support or endorsement.
- 3 (2) Any violation of this section shall be proven by clear and 4 convincing evidence.
