## HOUSE BILL 2933

By Representatives Wallace, Kenney, Anderson, Darneille, Roberts, Kelley, Hankins, Hasegawa, and Chase

- 1 AN ACT Relating to assessment of prior learning at institutions of 2 higher education; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
  - NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that adult learners entering workforce and academic programs will comprise a growing percentage of higher education enrollments in coming years. It for strategically important, а vital economy and qlobal competitiveness, to ensure that adult learners through move postsecondary education in the most efficient manner possible and enter the workforce well-prepared.
    - (2) The legislature also finds that Washington must make an effort to more effectively use resources at the state's public two-year and four-year institutions of higher education to facilitate wider and deeper adult participation in postsecondary education.
- 15 (3) The legislature also finds that adult learners encounter 16 barriers in pursuit of their postsecondary education. Institutional 17 policies and procedures regarding the acceptance of prior learning 18 credits are not aligned with accreditation rules and national best 19 practices.

- 1 (4) Therefore, it is the legislature's intent to create pathways 2 for adult learners to gain credit for learning from a variety of 3 sources so that college level learning acquired before enrollment can 4 be applied toward academic and workforce degrees.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) The higher education coordinating board 5 6 shall convene a work group that includes representatives from the state 7 board for community and technical colleges, the workforce training and education coordinating board, the council of presidents, and the two-8 year and four-year institutions of higher education to examine policies 9 related to the acceptance of prior learning credits at institutions of 10 11 higher education. The work group shall make policy recommendations in the following two areas related to prior learning assessment, giving 12 special consideration to recommendations made by the council for adult 13 and experiential learning and accreditation rules adopted by the 14 northwest commission on colleges and universities: 15
  - (a) The proportion of two-year and four-year academic and workforce degrees that can be comprised of credits granted through the assessment of prior learning; and
  - (b) The applicability of prior learning credits toward general education requirements and major-specific requirements.
  - (2) The study shall also include recommendations on implementation of the work group's recommendations at public two-year and four-year institutions of higher education.
- 24 (3) The work group shall report to the appropriate committees of 25 the legislature by December 1, 2008.
